16. An sodium chloride dissolves in water. What happens to the sodium and chloride ions? The sodium and chloride ions are separated and surrounded by the water molecules.

17. Explain the orientation of the water molecules around the sodium ions and chloride ions. Because the sodium ion is positively charged, it attracts the negatively charged portion of the water molecule (the oxygen atom) and repels the positively charged portion of the water molecule (the hydrogen atoms). Because the chloride ion is negatively charged, it attracts the positively charged portion of the water molecule and repels the negatively charged portion.

18. How does the strength of the attraction between water molecules and sodium and chloride ions compare with the strength of the attraction between the sodium ions and chloride ions? How do you know?

The attraction between the water molecules and the sodium and chloride ions is greater than the attraction between the sodium and chloride ions. The greater strength of attraction between the water molecules and the ions is what causes the solvation process to occur.
