2. **Scientific method:** *Making observation/collect data, develop a hypothesis, conduct experiment, Re-examining the hypothesis and accept or reject it, Make conclusion*
3. **Hypothesis:** *Untested explanation*
4. **Theory**- *Tested and confirmed hypothesis*
A THEORY is a well-tested and widely accepted view that best explains certain scientific observations
5. **Paradigm**- *A theory that explains a large number of interrelated aspects of the natural world*
6. **Hydrosphere**- *Includes all water on earth (fresh water found in streams, lakes, and glaciers)*
7. **Atmosphere:** *The envelope of gases surrounding the earth, thin blanket of air, over 3.5miles*
8. **Biosphere**- *includes all life*
9. **Geosphere**- *Solid earth, extends from the surface to the center of the planet. LARGEST of Earth's 4 spheres, consists of the crust, mantle, and core*
 - **Crust**- *thin, rocky outer skin. Less dense, many rock types*
 - **Oceanic crust**- *dense, basaltic rock*
 - **Mantle**- *more than 82% of earth's volume.*
 - **Upper mantle**- *Lithosphere: entire crust and uppermost mantle.*
Asthenosphere: soft layer
 - **Lower mantle**- *VERY HOT strengthens with depth*
 - **Outer Core**- *Liquid layer, earth's magnetic field*
 - **Inner core**- *solid*
