**Cellular Respiration & Photosynthesis**

**Cellular Respiration:** The process by which cells break down glucose to produce energy (ATP). It occurs in the mitochondria and consists of three main stages: Glycolysis, the Citric Acid Cycle, and the Electron Transport Chain.

**Photosynthesis:** The process by which plants and other organisms use light energy to convert carbon dioxide and water into glucose and oxygen. It occurs in the chloroplasts and consists of two main stages: the Light-Dependent Reactions and the Calvin Cycle.

**Mendel's Laws:**


- Law of Segregation:** Each individual has two alleles for each trait, one from each parent. These alleles separate during meiosis.
- Law of Independent Assortment:** The inheritance of one trait is independent of the inheritance of another trait.

**Genotypes and Phenotypes:**

- Genotype:** The genetic makeup of an organism.
- Phenotype:** The observable characteristics of an organism.

**Genetic Crosses:**

- Punnett Squares:** Used to predict the probability of offspring genotypes and phenotypes.
- Test Cross:** A cross between an individual with a dominant phenotype and a homozygous recessive individual to determine the genotype of the dominant parent.



**Microbiology**

**Microorganisms:** Small organisms that are not visible to the naked eye. They include bacteria, fungi, and viruses.

**Cell Structure:**

- Prokaryotes:** Lack a nucleus and other membrane-bound organelles.
- Eukaryotes:** Have a nucleus and other membrane-bound organelles.

**Antibiotics:** Drugs that kill or inhibit the growth of bacteria.


**Evolution:** The change in the heritable characteristics of a population over time.

**Gene Flow:** The movement of alleles between populations.




**Population Genetics**

**Hardy-Weinberg Equilibrium:** A principle that states that allele and genotype frequencies in a population will remain constant from generation to generation if the population is not evolving.

**Genetic Bottleneck:** A sharp reduction in the size of a population due to environmental events.

**Components:**

- Phosphate Group:** Attached to the 5' carbon of the sugar.
- Sugar:** Deoxyribose sugar attached to the 3' carbon.
- Nitrogenous Base:** Attached to the 1' carbon.
