EKG ANATOMY



WAVE - The wave that represents the electrical activity of the heart. The P wave represents the atria, the QRS complex represents the ventricles, and the T wave represents the ventricles during repolarization.

AMPLITUDE - The height of the wave, measured in millivolts (mV). The normal range for the P wave is 0.5-2.5 mV, for the QRS complex is 0.5-2.5 mV, and for the T wave is 0.5-2.5 mV.

DURATION - The width of the wave, measured in milliseconds (ms). The normal range for the P wave is 0.08-0.12 seconds, for the QRS complex is 0.06-0.10 seconds, and for the T wave is 0.16-0.24 seconds.

EKG Rhythms

- Normal Sinus Rhythm** - Regular rhythm with a rate of 60-100 bpm, P waves before each QRS, and a PR interval of 0.12-0.20 seconds.
- Sinus Bradycardia** - Regular rhythm with a rate less than 60 bpm.
- Sinus Tachycardia** - Regular rhythm with a rate greater than 100 bpm.
- Sinus Arrest** - Absence of P waves for a short period of time.
- Sinus Exit Block** - Absence of P waves for a short period of time, followed by a normal P wave.
- First Degree AV Block** - Prolonged PR interval greater than 0.20 seconds.
- Second Degree AV Block Type I (Wenckebach)** - Progressive PR interval prolongation until a QRS complex is dropped.
- Second Degree AV Block Type II (Mobitz II)** - Absence of QRS complexes without preceding PR interval prolongation.
- Third Degree AV Block** - Complete dissociation between P waves and QRS complexes.
- Bundle Branch Block** - Abnormal QRS complex morphology due to delayed conduction through the bundle branches.
- Myocardial Infarction (MI)** - ST segment elevation or depression, and T wave inversion.
- Myocardial Ischemia** - ST segment depression and T wave inversion.
- Myocardial Infarction (MI) - ST Segment Elevation MI (STEMI)** - ST segment elevation greater than 2 mm in two leads.
- Myocardial Infarction (MI) - Non-ST Segment Elevation MI (NSTEMI)** - ST segment depression or T wave inversion.
- Myocardial Infarction (MI) - Unstable Angina** - ST segment depression or T wave inversion.
- Myocardial Infarction (MI) - Unstable Angina** - ST segment depression or T wave inversion.



Electrical Therapy Basics



- Defibrillation** - The process of delivering a high-energy electrical shock to the heart to restore a normal rhythm.
- Synchronized Cardioversion** - The process of delivering a lower-energy electrical shock to the heart to restore a normal rhythm.
- Transcutaneous Pacing** - The process of delivering a low-energy electrical shock to the heart to maintain a normal rhythm.

Airway Management



- Basic Airway Management** - Includes head-tilt/chin-lift, jaw-thrust, and oral/nasal airway insertion.
- Advanced Airway Management** - Includes endotracheal intubation, supraglottic airway devices, and cricoid pressure.

Post-Resuscitation Care



- Follow the ABCs** - Airway, Breathing, Circulation, Disability, Exposure.
- Temperature Management** - Maintain normothermia (36-37.5°C).
- Fluid Management** - Avoid fluid overload.
- Electrolyte Management** - Monitor and correct abnormalities.
- Organ Protection** - Monitor and maintain organ function.

Acute Coronary Syndromes (ACS)

- Unstable Angina** - Chest pain at rest, increasing in frequency or duration.
- ST Segment Elevation MI (STEMI)** - ST segment elevation greater than 2 mm in two leads.
- Non-ST Segment Elevation MI (NSTEMI)** - ST segment depression or T wave inversion.
- Unstable Angina** - Chest pain at rest, increasing in frequency or duration.



Stroke Assessment and Treatment

- Stroke Assessment** - Includes the ABCs, NIHSS, and mRS.
- Stroke Treatment** - Includes thrombolysis, thrombectomy, and supportive care.

Code Termination

- Consult with medical director before code termination.**
- Recognize signs of death or irreversible non-survivable conditions.**
