

# HEALTHY SLEEP HABITS



Improve your sleep with some positive lifestyle changes and consistent sleep habits

## 1 REGULAR SLEEP SCHEDULE

Try to maintain a consistent sleep pattern 7 days a week. Getting up at the same time every day can help.



## 2 RELAXING BEDTIME ROUTINE

Spend time before bed relaxing: read a book, meditate, stretch, do yoga, have a shower or bath. Avoid difficult conversations, activities or work.



## 3 AVOID STIMULANTS

Don't drink caffeine, sugary or energy drinks in the evening. Avoid nicotine before bed. Only drink alcohol in moderation at night, if at all.



## 4 GOOD SLEEP ENVIRONMENT

Keep your bedroom clean, tidy and comfortable. Use a quality mattress and bedding. Keep the bedroom aired, and a temperature between 60 -70 °F (17-21 °C)



## 5 BLOCK OUT NOISE AND LIGHT

Make sure the bedroom is dark and quiet. Use blackout curtains or a sleep mask. Use earplugs, white noise, a fan or music to mask external noise.



## 6 ONLY SLEEP AND INTIMACY

Only use the bed for sleep and intimacy with a partner. Avoid watching TV or using other devices in bed. That will help associate the bed with sleep.



## 7 EXERCISE AND DAYLIGHT

Try to do regular exercise, but not too intense before bedtime. Spend time outside in the daylight. Even a short walk during the day can improve sleep.



## 8 EAT WELL

Try to eat a balanced, healthy diet. Avoid heavy, fatty, fried or spicy food late in the evening if you get indigestion. Bananas, yogurt or healthy cereal are good bedtime snacks.
